Findings:

Doing fine. No issue

Treatment given while admitted:

Inj Palonosetron 0.25mg + Inj.Dexa 8mg in 100ml NS

Cap.Aprecap 125mg PO -DAY1

Tab.Famotidine 20mg PO-DAY1

Inj.Avil 2cc slow IV push -DAY1

Inj.Paclitaxel 140 mg in 500ml NS over 1 hrs on- DAY1

Treatment advised post discharge:

Cap.Aprecap 80mg — 1-0-0 x day2/day3 (empty stomach)

Tab.Ultracet ----- sos for pain

Syp.Duphalac 20-30ml - sos for constipation

Tab. Domstal 10mg 1---1---1 x 2days (Before meal)

Tab Microtel AM 80mg 1--0--0
